



## **January Produce News**

**Potatoes** - Idaho harvest is now complete. Volume and quality has been better than expected. Pricing is beginning to stabilize.

**Lettuce** -Supplies are ample, shipping from Yuma, Arizona has begun. Pricing should remain steady with good weather.

**Onions** - Now shipping storage onions. Supplies are ample with a good supply of larger onions. Market should be steady through January.

**Tomatoes** - Florida now shipping good quality and quantity. This should continue throughout January, with good weather.

**Grapes** - Grapes are now imported from Chile. Pricing is steady and quality is good and should remain so through January.

**Strawberries** - Florida strawberries now shipping with good quality and quantity. Freezing temperatures are an issue this time of year.

**Apples**- Harvesting is now complete. New crop apples are now shipping. More varieties than ever and in greater quantities this year.

Weather is a factor in produce quality, price and availability in January. Freezing weather can change the market overnight. Two major growing areas, Arizona and Florida, are at risk of substantial crop loss this time of year. Let's hope for good weather.
