



February Produce News

Potatoes - Idaho harvest is now complete. Many Idaho packers are now shipping Burbank carton potatoes for baking potatoes.

Lettuce - Supplies are ample, shipping from Yuma, Arizona. Pricing should remain steady with good weather.

Onions - Now shipping new crop onions from Mexico. Early reports are good on quality and yield.

Tomatoes - Florida and Mexico now shipping good quality and quantity. This should continue throughout February with good weather.

Grapes - Grapes are now imported from Chile. Pricing is steady and quality is good and should remain so through February.

Strawberries - Florida strawberries now shipping with good quality and quantity. Freezing temperatures are an issue this time of year.

Apples- Harvesting is now complete. New crop apples are now shipping. More varieties than ever and in greater quantities this year.

Weather is a factor in produce quality, price and availability in February. Freezing weather can change the market overnight. Two major growing areas, Arizona and Florida, are at risk of substantial crop loss this time of year. Let's hope for good weather.
