



November Produce News

Potatoes - Idaho harvesting will soon be complete. Volume and quality has been better than expected. Pricing has dropped last few weeks. Market is near the bottom with a slight increase possible in November.

Lettuce - Supplies are ample, shipping from Huron California. Transition to winter growing region in Yuma Arizona later this month.

Onions - Now shipping storage onions. Supplies are ample with a good supply of larger onions. Market should be steady through November.

Tomatoes - Florida should be shipping good quality and quantity this month.

Grapes - California grapes nearing the end of the season. Red grapes are a good choice this month. Holiday grapes are a large sweet red grape, from California with supplies lasting until Christmas.

Strawberries - California strawberry harvest may be down. Should cause the market to rise and quality is always an issue this time of year.

Apples- Most varieties of apples are now shipping new crop. More varieties will be harvested in greater quantities this year.

Seedless naval oranges will be shipping in a week or two. Tangerine, tangelo and other citrus fruits will be available by months end.
