# **June Produce News**

**Potatoes-** Stronger pricing on 70 count and larger size baking potatoes. New crop Red Potatoes now shipping.

**Lettuce-** Lettuce is now shipping out of the Salinas Valley in California. Pricing is steady and quality is good on iceberg and romaine.

**Onions-** Supplies and prices are steady. Market may soften when California opens new growing areas.

**Tomatoes-** Florida has a great crop and prices have dropped. Quality is improving with each week. New growing areas soon to open.

**Apples-** Great fall harvest in Washington state. Seven different varieties now in stock.

**Grapes-** California now shipping white grapes. Red grapes shipping from Chile until mid to late May. Quality is good and pricing should drop as we get further into the season.

**Strawberries-** Berries now shipping from northern California. Pricing and quality are good for this time of year.

**Season Concerns** Florida is now shipping zucchini, yellow squash, green peppers and cucumbers. Volume is increasing, causing pricing to decrease.

**Now is the best time to serve fresh fruit and vegetables. With summer upon us, most fresh produce will soon be at its peak. Pricing is down and quality is at its best during peak season.**
